
## New Requirement Under "Ownership" Step In APEP

Recently AHCCCS implemented a requirement in the AHCCCS Provider Enrollment Portal which requires action of rendering/servicing provider in the "Add Provider Controlling Interest/Ownership Details". AHCCCS is not intending to name rendering providers as "Owners", and within the step, classifies them as rendering/servicing, as shown in the example below. The purpose of the updates is to provide an avenue for rendering/servicing providers to answer questions related to criminal convictions, adverse actions imposed my Medicare or other state/federal programs, and information related to adverse actions pursuant to 455 CFR subpart B.



Follow the instructions below to complete the requirements of the step:
