RE: Clarification of Proposal RFP YH19-0001 – AHCCCS Complete Care

Dear Ms. Harley,

This letter is in response to your letter of January 29, 2018, requesting that UnitedHealthcare Community Plan (UHCCP) describe how Leslie Schwalbe and Lilli R. Correll will be substantially involved in the ongoing operation of the AHCCCS Complete Care contract (Contract), if awarded, consistent with Paragraph 19, Page 297 of the RFP. Below we describe their planned involvement.

Leslie Schwalbe will be substantially involved in the ongoing operation of the Contract, if awarded. She has 19 years' experience in Arizona within the behavioral health community, including six years with the Division of Behavioral Health Services, within the Arizona Department of Health Services. Her role in the ongoing operation of the Contract includes the following:

- Lead our Behavioral Health Provider Advisory Council, which met multiple times in 2017 and will continue via monthly post-award meetings. We highlighted this council in our RFP response and Ms. Schwalbe was instrumental in its development.
- Establish and support our Provider-led Integrated Care Coordination Advisory Committee, dedicated to ensuring smooth transition to our Provider-led Integrated Care Coordination Model, as further described in detail in our RFP response,
- Assist with development of the Behavioral Health network, as necessary to fill any network gaps identified,
- Participate in creation of policies to establishing behavioral health membership on our Member Advocacy Council and our Governance Committee, and
- Support the Governance Committee.

Recently, our Behavioral Health Medical Director, Dr. Jeffrey Schwimmer retired. We are pleased that Dr. Edward M Gentile, D.O., M.B.A., F.A.P.A. accepted our offer of employment to begin on February 5, 2018. Dr. Gentile's most recent role was Chief Medical Officer at Community Partners, Inc. providing medical leadership to a provider organization contracted with payers in the Medicaid, Medicare, commercial and private sectors. He also serves as psychiatrist for one of two Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) teams contracted to the current integrated health plan (formerly known as the Regional Behavioral Health Authority) for persons with serious mental illness who are Medicaid enrollees. His vast experience will support his role as our Behavioral Health Medical Director.

As of the submission date of RFP YH19-0001, we did not yet have confirmation of Dr. Gentile's employment. UHCCP respectfully requests that Dr. Edward Gentile replace Lilli Correll in our oral presentations. Attached you will find his resume.
