AHCCCS HIPAA 5010 276/277 <u>Batch</u> Transaction Testing Overview

The following summarizes our procedures and expectations related to HIPAA 5010 276/277 transaction testing with our trading partners. If you have any questions, comments or suggestions please let us know.

Schedule:

Trading Partner Testing with all 276/277 submitters/receivers: Beginning July 1, 2011 and running through December 31, 2011

Approach:

- 1. All test files will be run against the production claims environment; therefore all requests should be related to production claims submitted to AHCCCS.
- 2. AHCCCS will run according to a published testing schedule:
 - 276 5010 test files for the regularly scheduled daily batch processes must be received by no later than 4:00pm Monday thru Friday.
 - 277 5010 test files will be produced nightly Monday thru Friday and will be available by 7:00am the next business day.
 - ▶ Refer to the 276/277 Testing Calendar for more information.
- 3. All inbound 276 5010 test files will be validated through the AHCCCS Validator prior to acceptance by AHCCCS
- 4. All outbound 277 5010 test files will be validated through the AHCCCS Validator prior to placement on the SFTP Server.
- 5. AHCCCS will attempt to run files as consistent with production data processing as permitted within the constraints of the dedicated test environment.
- 6. 276 5010 test files can have any file name under 30 characters in length with no spaces in the file name and placed in directory XXX/TEST/EDI-IN where XXX is your folder name (file names cannot end in .TMP)
- 7. 277 5010 test files will be named as follows: AZD277-ppppp-yymmdd-nnnnnn.TXT
 - pppppp is the 6-digit AHCCCS Registration ID (pos 1-6 of element GS02 in the 276 file)
 - yymmdd is the process date
 - nnnnnnn is element ISA13 from the 276 file
 - placed in directory XXX/TEST/EDI-OUT
 - Acknowledgments (999, 824 or TA1) are placed in the EDI-OUT folder

Testing Standards/Expectations:

- 1. Prior to starting application testing, trading partner should validate 2 files for compliance using the Community Manager. If you do not currently have a community manager account send a request via email to: <u>EDICustomerSupport@azahcccs.gov</u>.
- 2. Recommended # of test files that a trading partner must successfully exchange to "pass" testing (see column 3) are the minimum. Trading Partners may elect to and are encouraged to exchange as many test files as desired.
- 3. Once a Trading Partner feels they have successful completed all applicable testing for the 276/277 transactions, an email should be submitted to us indicating your readiness to move forward with this transaction in the production environment: Lori.Petre@azahcccs.gov. We will then follow-up with you to confirm the date this transition will occur.
- 4. All Trading Partner test completions will be tracked by AHCCCS.

Helpful Hints:

- 1. All test files must be identified as "T-test" rather than "P-production" in the ISA15 element, and should reflect the appropriate 5010 version information as outlined in the Draft 5010 Companion Guide (see available documentation below).
- 2. The GS02 Sender Code is composed of a 6 digit AHCCCS Registration ID + 2 digit Location Code

Transaction Delimiters:

AHCCCS' delimiters for outbound transactions:

Element delimiter = "{" (left French bracket, position 4 in ISA) Composite delimiter = "|" (the pipe, ISA16, no change) Segment terminator = "~" (a tilde, position 106 in ISA, no change) Repetition Separator = "^" (a carat, ISA11, new)
