Re: Health Choice Arizona, Inc. – Response to AHCCCS Initial Response Letter dated July 6, 2017

Dear Ms. Davis:

This letter is in follow up to the notification of acquisition and request for prior approval sent by Health Choice Arizona, Inc. ("Health Choice") on May 26, 2017. With the notice, Health Choice submitted a Transition Plan, detailing the proposed merger of IASIS Healthcare Corporation, the ultimate parent corporation of Health Choice, with a wholly owned subsidiary of Steward Health Care System LLC ("Steward"), in accordance with the AHCCCS Contractor Operations Manual ("ACOM"), Policy 317 (Change in Contractor Organizational Structure) and contract YH14-0001-07, Section D, Paragraph 52 (Merger, Reorganization, Joint Venture and Change of Ownership) and Section D, Paragraph 44 (Material Change to Business Operations).

We are in receipt of AHCCCS's initial response letter dated July 6, 2017, which contained requests for clarification and documentation. We respond to those requests as follows:

- <u>Anticipated Effective Date of the Proposed Acquisition</u> Subject to the state and regulatory approvals noted below, the parties are seeking to consummate the merger effective as of August 31, 2017.
- <u>Employee Identification Number / Tax Identification Number (EIN/TIN)</u>
 Health Choice's EIN/TIN will not change as a result of the proposed merger.

<u>Anticipated State and Regulatory Approvals for the Acquisition</u>

The material state and regulatory approvals required for this acquisition, other than approval by AHCCCS, are as follows:

Arizona Department of Insurance – A Form A filing for approval regarding Health Choice Insurance Co. (a separate IASIS subsidiary), a licensed Arizona Domestic Health Care Services Organization that historically provided a Marketplace product and that anticipates participating in a licensed program outside of Arizona, was filed on June 16, 2017.



- Utah Department of Insurance A Form A filing for approval regarding Health Choice Utah, Inc., (a separate IASIS subsidiary), a licensed Utah Domestic Health Maintenance Organization that serves as a Utah Medicaid managed care plan, was filed on June 16, 2017.
- Federal Trade Commission ("FTC") A U.S. Hart-Scott-Rodino Antitrust Improvements Act of 1976 ("HSR Act") pre-merger notification was filed for the proposed merger. The applicable waiting period under the HSR Act must have expired or been terminated in order to proceed with the merger. The request for early termination of the waiting period was granted by the FTC effective June 26, 2017.

In addition, other pre-closing and post-closing filings are required for other IASIS subsidiaries, but we do not anticipate any additional material pre-closing approvals. These other pre-closing filings include insurance-related notices to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services and the Utah Department of Health, and filings for IASIS's various hospital and other health provider entities.

Articles of Incorporation, including Affiliation Agreements

The corporate entity, Health Choice, is staying intact and its Articles of Incorporation will not be revised as a result of the proposed merger. Further, no affiliation agreements, as defined in ACOM Policy 317, have been or will be established between Health Choice and any of its affiliates as a result of the proposed merger.

Automatic Clearing House (ACH) Vendor Authorization Form

Health Choice does not plan to change its banking information at the time of the merger. As such, we do not believe that the ACH Vendor Authorization Form requires any updates. If Health Choice makes changes after closing, it will follow AHCCCS procedures.
