From October 1, 2024, to November 1, 2024, the population decreased by 33,020 members, or 2%.

The major increases in the AHCCCS population from October 1, 2024, to November 1, 2024, were:

- 12,991 Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA)
- 3,497 SOBRA Pregnant

The major decreases in the AHCCCS population from October 1, 2024, to November 1, 2024, were:

- 18,664 Prop 204 Restoration (0 100% FPL)
- 14.083 SOBRA Child
- 12,399 1931 AHCCCS for Families & Children
- 1,529 KidsCare
- 1,354 Adult Expansion (100% 133% FPL)
