HPC Specialty Pharmacy	Section 3, Paragraph 2	2	Page 2, Section 3 states that a vendor shall supply "the provision of anti-hemophilic and/or blood disorder medications, supplies, the disposal of medications, and the coordination and delivery of these products and services". Nowhere in here do I see any mention of nursing services for this patient population. How is that going to be addressed for patients needing or requesting home infusions?	Nursing services are billed and reimbursed separately. They are not included in this procurement.
2.				We are an independent Specialty Pharmacy. We do not have access to 340B pricing. Will I be competing against Specialty Pharmacies that have 340B pricing available to them?	We cannot predict who will submit a response to the RFP when it is issued.
