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7.	02/03/23 Updated 02/15/23	Medicare Advantage (D-SNP) Requirements	AHCCCS will continue to require successful bidders, or their corporate affiliates, to be Medicare Advantage Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNP) that manage and provide Medicare benefits to ALTCS E-PD Full Benefit Dual Eligible members in their Geographic Service Area(s). The D-SNP plan shall be operational by January 1, 2025 and designated by CMS as a Fully Integrated Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (FIDE SNP), according to CMS requirements as outlined in the CY2023 Medicare Advantage final rule published May 9, 2022, including the requirement that the plan has exclusively aligned enrollment.  Exclusively aligned enrollment means a full benefit dual eligible member is enrolled with a Medicaid health plan that is (1)the same organization as the D-SNP, (2)the D-SNP's parent organization, or (3) another entity owned and controlled by the D-SNP's parent organization.  In conjunction with FIDE SNP requirements effective January 1, 2025, AHCCCS intends to require its contracted D-SNPs to implement enhanced integrated care management tools, which may include and may not be limited to Medicare and Medicaid combined: member ID card, appeals process, Member Handbook, and Provider Directory. Incumbent ALTCS E-PD Contractors that are not awarded a Contract for this RFP will be required to maintain their D-SNP plan through December 31, 2024.  Update: D-SNPs that are required as a result of the ALTCS EPD YH24-0001 procurement will be effective January 1, 2025. Therefore, CMS Medicare Application (MA) activity, including service area requests, is not required for MA Contract Year (CY) 2024. All such MA Application activity necessary upon completion of the procurement will occur for MA CY2025, with such applications due to CMS in mid-February 2024.
