## **TO: Maureen Wade, AHCCCS RE: Heart Transplant Policy Revision**

# Cyrcahealth Review & Recommendation

Cyrcahealth's heart transplant reviewer, Dr. Jackie O'Donnell (Krannert Institute of Cardiology, Heart Transplant Program, Clarian, Indianapolis) has reviewed the proposed changes to the AHCCCS heart transplant policy and has commented the following.

**<u>Comments/Opinion</u>**: In regards to the use of heart transplantation for patients with nonischemic cardiomyopathy, the consultant's opinion was that heart transplant is indicated in selected adult patients who meet criteria, and for whom all other medical and surgical modalities have been exhausted.

Many patients have not been maximally medically managed and their physicians need to make a great effort to adjust the patient's medications, and also do right and left heart catheterizations trying to find anything amenable to stenting, etc. Obviously these patients need to be seen by cardiologists trained in chronic heart failure and cardiac transplantation. The transplant center should do everything in its power to keep the patient's heart in place *without* a transplant, but in some patients, the LV +/- RV continue to fail and the patient starts to have low perfusion with involvement of the kidneys/liver. At that point, other medical modalities need to be employed, such as LVAD or transplant.

**<u>Recommendation</u>**: Otherwise, except for above and also any prior comments, proposed policy changes as submitted for review should stand.
