ACOM POLICY 432, BENEFIT COORDINATION AND FISCAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES AND PHYSICAL HEALTH SERVICES

In addition the Policy was revised to provide clarification on crisis responsibility and responsibility for payment of claims related to communication disorders.
