AHCCCS CONTRACTOR OPERATIONS MANUAL (ACOM)

Pursuant to Laws 2019, 1st Regular Session, Chapter 305, behavioral health services for children in DCS custody were anticipated to transition from the RBHA Contractors to DCS/ CMDP effective October 1, 2020. However, this implementation has been delayed. Revisions that have already been completed for ACOM and AMPM Policies and Attachment(s), related to this anticipated integration [listed in document provided below], will remain in the impacted policies but will not be applicable until such time that CMDP behavioral health service integration is implemented. Revisions unrelated to the integration of behavioral health services for CMDP members; will continue to be effective October 1, 2020.

ACOM POLICY 317, CHANGE IN CONTRACTOR ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

O ATTACHMENT A, ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES SUBCONTRACT CHECKLIST

Attachment A was revised to update requirements including specific duties of the subcontractor relating to coordination of care for all members. A requirement was also added that the subcontractor shall not arbitrarily deny or reduce the amount, duration, or scope of a required service solely because of the diagnosis, type of illness, or condition of the member, and a provision that requires the subcontractor to assist members in understanding their right to file grievances and appeals in conformance with all AHCCCS Grievance and Appeal System and member rights policies. *Implementation Date 10/01/20*.
